CHIEF EXECUTIVE'S ORDER

Subject: Roadworks Speed Limit Order - N25 between Killineen and Lemybrien

I, Fergus Galvin, Director of Services, Roads, Water & Environment, by virtue of the powers conferred on Waterford City & County Chief Executive by the Local Government Act, 2001, as amended by the Local Government Reform Act 2014, and in accordance with Chief Executive Order dated 10th October, 2016, delegating functions to me under Section 154 of the Local Government Act 2001, hereby make the following order:

THAT under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004, it is the intention of Waterford City and County Council to impose Roadworks Speed Limits, in the interests of road safety, as follows:-

From the 60km/h speed limit on the eastern side of the Pike hill to the 60kmh speed limit at western side of Lemybrien. The Road Works Speed Limit to be applied is 60 km/h.

The Road Works Speed Limit Order is required in the interests of traffic safety and worker safety to facilitate the resurfacing works on the N25 between Killineen and Lemybrien. The Road Works Speed Limit will apply with effect from Wednesday 14th August 2019 and will remain in place for the duration of the works or a period of six months, whichever is of shorter duration.
