WATERFORD METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of the powers vested on them by Section 131A of the Local Government Acts 1925 to 2014, Section 84 (as substituted by Section 15 of the Road Traffic Act 2002 (No 12 of 2002)) of the Road Traffic Act 1961 (No. 24 of 1961), and having consulted with the Commissioner of the Garda Síochána hereby makes the following Bye-Laws in respect of the area comprising the County of Waterford.

Citation

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Waterford Metropolitan District Council (Appointed Stands Amendment No 2) Bye-Laws, 2017
2. These Byelaws and the Waterford Metropolitan District Council (Appointed Stands Bye-Laws), 2015 and the Waterford Metropolitan District Council (Appointed Stands Amendment) Bye-Laws, 2017 may be cited together as the Waterford Metropolitan District Council (Appointed Stands Bye-Laws), 2015 to 2017.

Commencement

3. These Bye-Laws shall commence on the XXth day of XXXX, 2017.

Interpretation

4. (1) In these bye-laws:

“Byelaws of 2015” means the Waterford Metropolitan District Council (Appointed Stands Bye-Laws), 2015

Amendment of the Principal Byelaws

 (i) substituting for item 5 the following;
